

Application Information Checklist

Items needed to be submitted with Veteran application:

- Completed IVH Application (Veterans must use the blue form 475-0409: Spouses of veterans must use the gray form 475-0410)
- Signatures on the bottom of page three (3) to include applicant/legal representative; two (2) County Commissioners; and a notary signature verifying authentic signatures of the two Commissioners
- Complete History and Physical dated within three months of the receipt of application
- Completed Personal Functional Assessment (Form 475-0837)
- Copy of DD 214 (Honorable Discharge from the military: Spouses will need to supply Veteran's)*
- Copy of marriage certificate/divorce/legal separation (Whichever is applicable for most recent marriage. All spouses will need to supply marriage certificate.)
- Copy of death certificate of spouse (if applicable. All surviving spouses must supply.)*

Items needed by date of admission:

- Copy of birth certificate*
- Copy of all Powers of Attorney
- Financial forms and supporting verification of all income and assets
- Copies of all life insurance policies
- Copy of prepaid burial if applicable
- Copies of Medicare, Medicare Part D and any other health insurance cards
- Copy of Nursing Home insurance policy or Long-Term Care insurance policy
- Copy of deed for burial lot(s)
- Copy of Social Security card

Items needed to be submitted with Spouse application:

- All of the above Veteran requirements also apply to spouse applications.
- If applying as a surviving spouse of a former spouse and you remarried, you must provide documentation on all subsequent marriages. If you are currently married and are applying as a surviving spouse of a former spouse, you are not eligible for admission as a surviving spouse.

Items needed by date of admission:

- All of the above Veteran requirements also apply to spouse applications.

***NOTE: You will need to provide certified copies if you are not already receiving Social Security or other government income.**
